Here's where you come in: Create a 12.5 inch, unfinished quilt block, featuring a South Florida theme. Use your imagination!

Please create your block with 100 percent cotton fabrics, prewashed and pressed. (Embellishments accepted.)

Thirty blocks will be chosen by a panel of judges, and those blocks will be made into a final quilt, by the Palm Beach Quilt Guild, to be displayed at the Norton Museum of Art. Prizes will be awarded to the creators of the 30 chosen quilt blocks. Blocks cannot be returned.

The deadline to receive the blocks is June 30th.
